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Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

- 1. We have audited the accompanying statement of standalone financial results (the "Statement") of BCPL Railway Infrastructure Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024 attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
- 2. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Statement:
- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024.

Basis for Opinion

3. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended (the Act).
